

STRASBURG WALKING TOUR

In the mid 1980's a number of caring Strasburg citizens created a good walking tour that shares the history and architecture with anyone who follows the seven signs. There will be mention of the Mt. Zion Methodist Church, the Riverview Cemetery, more old houses and some other tidbits of Strasburg History.
